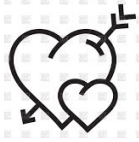




STEP #6: HAND STITCH THE OPENING:



THREAD THE NEEDLE:

1. You need a Hand stitching needle
2. Cut a piece of All-Purpose thread that is the length of your arm to your shoulder.
3. Insert the end of your thread through your needle and pull it down so they are almost the same length, but one end will be shorter.

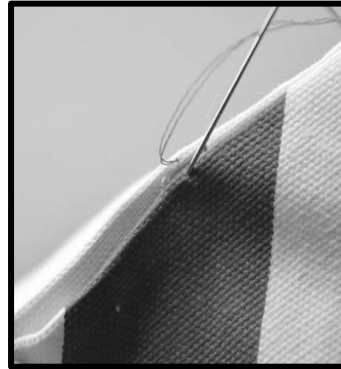
ONE END WILL BE A FEW INCHES SHORTER THAN THE OTHER!

4. Knot the end of the longer thread.

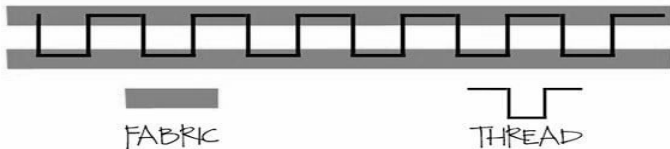
BLIND-STITCH / LADDER-STITCH:

The VIDEO TUTORIAL will help you understand this step more completely.

1. Find the opening on your Bean Bag and insert the tip of the needle into the opening.
2. Pull the needle up so the knot is buried in the seam.
3. Insert needle into the top of the fold on one side, and pick up a little tiny stitch.
4. Exactly where your needle came out on one side, you will insert your needle into the fold on the other side. Make sure your needle is parallel to the fold. *(If you do this stitch correctly, the stitch will be completely invisible).*



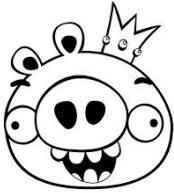
BLIND STITCH DIAGRAM

STEP #7: DECORATE THE BEAN BAG:



ANGRY BIRD FACES:

1. Look up faces on the internet of the Angry Bird Faces you like. You can use any of the faces here, or find your own.
2. Cut the pieces out of felt scraps to make a design that looks like these faces.
3. Heat up the hot glue gun.
4. Glue pieces to the face of the bean bag.
5. Make sure the pieces are glued securely with no edges coming up.



STENCILS:

1. Find or make a Stencil that you want to use. You can look on the internet to find options.
2. Turn the stencil upside down and mark the pieces on the back of the felt pieces you are using.
3. Cut out the felt pieces and turn them right side up.
4. Arrange the felt pieces onto the bean bag into desired location.
- 5 Heat up the hot glue gun.
6. Glue pieces to the face of the bean bag.
7. Make sure the pieces are glued securely with no edges coming up.



FREEHAND DESIGN:

1. Look up designs on the internet or use your own design.
2. Cut out pieces from the felt scraps to make a design that that resembles your picture.
3. Heat up the hot glue gun.
4. Glue pieces of fabric to the front of the bean bag.
5. Make sure the pieces are glued securely with no edges coming up.
